Layers and Masks are Photoshop's most powerful tools. They allow us to edit an image selectively and non-destructively for maximum control, and to enhance it with eye-popping creative effects. But they come with an intimidating reputation that frightens many photographers away. This workshop adds the magic that will help you build a genuine understanding of how Layers and Masks work, and the confidence to apply them, unlocking the full potential of your photographs.



What You Will Learn:

- Why you need Layers and Masks and how they fit into your Photoshop workflow
- How to set up the Photoshop workspace for efficiently working with layers & masks
- Tools of the trade: selections, brushes and gradients
- Selective tonal and colour adjustments
- Local sharpening and blurring
- Combining multiple images and elements into composites
- Adding text, watermarks, borders, drop-shadows
- Using creative filters, transform tools, blending modes and other special effects

Who Should Attend: Photographers already familiar with Photoshop's basic editing techniques in any recent version of Photoshop or Elements, who are tired of being intimidated by Layers and Masks, and who want to take their image editing to the next level.

Workshop Length and Format: This is an intensive 1-day workshop that runs at my Dublin Shore studio from 10am-6pm with a 1-hour break for lunch (bring your own, or visit the nearby LaHave Bakery). It is presented classroom-style on an HD monitor so it is possible simply to watch and learn; however you are encouraged to bring your own laptop and images you wish to work on. Detailed take-home notes are provided for handy reference.
